District: Twin Rivers Unified

- Demographics: Latinx, African American, refugees from Afghanistan
- Big brother/sister
- Trauma-informed training*
- Goal: every student to be paired w/ mentor
 - ~10-15 students/mentor (total 700)
- Fall 2021 (beginning in mid-August) In-person, during their school hours- preferred*
 - Virtual still viable



Caroline Wenzel Elementary School (K-6)

Principal: Mr. Yang
Sacramento, CA
District: Sacramento City
Unified

- Longitudinal relationship b/twn mentor and mentee, tutor and tutee
- Address social determinants that contribute to edu disparities
 - Low SES
 - Home stressors
- Some students falling behind, reading below grade level
- Quality-based Intervention support



Caroline Wenzel Pilot Program (Summer 2021)


Soaring Egils Program

- ~50 students (gen ed)
- Depending on members' availability– likely 1 tutor/mentor per 10 tutees/mentees
- Start developing longitudinal relationship, through Fall 2021
- 6/28-7/30, 12-2:30p PST M-F
- M-Th: tutoring, F: workshops
 - Workshops – Split 2hr30min session into 3-4 workshop time slots

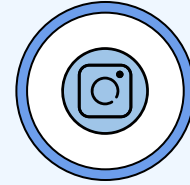
